



In order to keep everyone as safe as possible, we will be conducting our Fall CCD classes in a send-home format.


Each Sunday, at least one parent is asked to attend a 10-15min lesson preparation session in the Family Life Center. These will be offered after the 10AM Mass. Fr. Pat and MC will hand out folders for each family, give a brief overview of the lesson plan for that week, and distribute the week's craft/activity supplies for each child-and will be available to answer all questions about the week's lesson.

While parents are going over the lesson plan, students will meet in classrooms with their CCD teachers for a quick check-in and review of the lesson from the previous week (this will keep them in touch with their teachers for whenever we are capable of returning to a classroom settings).
